
<sup>1</sup>Individuals will be automatically excluded by law from all casinos in Singapore if they are undischarged bankrupts, receiving financial aid from the Government, living in subsidized HDB rental flats and have 6 or more months of rental arrears, and receiving legal aid.


<sup>2</sup>Individuals who are frequent local casino patrons and deemed to be financial vulnerable will be imposed with a visit limit by NCPG. For severe cases, an exclusion order may be imposed instead.












# Self-Exclusions (Foreigners)


### Age by Gender






## Voluntary Visit Limit









## Third-Party Visit Limit



### Number of Individuals Who Sought Help


