
²Individuals who are frequent local casino patrons and deemed to be financial vulnerable will be imposed with a visit limit by NCPG. For severe cases, an exclusion order may be imposed instead of a visit limit.





Profile of Applicant







Total no. of active self-exclusions (SCPR) = **19,699**






Self-Exclusions (Foreigners)

Age by Gender









Third-Party Visit Limit



Number of Individuals Who Sought Help








Number of Individuals Who Sought Help
